Earthcare Retreat October 26

For many years St. Ben's has had a focus on creation care. This includes being as conscious as we can about recycling, reusing and avoiding non-sustainable products. In 2015 a Hollister Institute class studied Pope Francis' encyclical *Laudato Si* which lays out the importance of integral ecology and defines the environmental crisis as spiritual at heart. From this, a group of people came together and formed Earthcare - intended to support one another in our environmental work, educate the congregation and engage in local activity. Over the years this group has done a number of things - you can check out the video which is on the church's home page (www.stbenslososos.org) - including hosting Matthew Fox and most recently organizing a west coast tour for Margaret Bullitt-Jonas culminating in a diocesan conference.

After such a successful event, this is a good time to take stock and to revision, to listen to one another and to the Holy Spirit and see what God has in store for us now. You are invited to join in a conversation about St. Benedict's and creation care on Saturday, October 26. This will be a retreat format with time for reflection, conversation, listening, and planning. It is open for all church members and friends with a heart for the environment and concern about making a difference while we still can. Led by Caro+ and Fr. Barry. 10am - 2:30pm. Special Appeal to Honor Bishop Mary & Bishop-Elect Lucinda

This is an important time for our Diocese as we prepare for the consecration of Bishop Elect Lucinda Ashby on January 11 and the celebration of Bishop Mary Gray-Reeves' ministry with us.
