The reading of the names of the congregation's faithful departed during the service and praying on their behalf is appropriate, as the Catechism reminds us, "because we still hold them in our love, and because we trust that in God's presence those who have chosen to serve him will grow in his love, until they see him as he is" (BCP, pg 862).
